First Epileptologists' Summer School in China

Where Chengdu, Sichuan Province, People's Republic of China

When August 7 – 14, 2011

Objectives Clinically-oriented, targeted to specialists of epilepsy care and focused on comprehensive aspects of diagnosis, treatment and rehabilitation of children and adults with epilepsy. The course will enable the participants to receive the up-to-date information and expert opinion on the main topics of clinical epileptology, to improve their competence and gain practical skills in the diagnostic work-up and decision-making concerning the management of different aspects of pediatric and adult epileptology.

Tutors: Around 20 international and domestic senior experts in epileptology

Students: Maximum of 60 specialists in neurology, neuropsychiatry, pediatric neurology, pediatrics from all over the world.

Language: It is given in English.

Application: To submit: 1, Application form (attached), 2, Curriculum vitae (CV) on 2 pages max and list of publications, 3, Letter of Recommendations: Reference letter from the supervisor.

Application deadline: March 20th, 2011.

Registration fee: 1000/1200 US dollars. It includes 8 nights accommodation in single room (\$1200) or double room share with another student (\$1000), full board and coffee breaks for entire duration of the course, access to all the educational activities (lectures, tutorials, case discussions, video-sessions, facility).

Course program: 1, Lectures (first 3 days): The tutors give lectures on the clinically relevant aspects on epileptology and conduct interactive case discussions and/or tutorials on EEG, imaging or clinical pharmacology; 2, Practical activities (rest 4 days): 8 – 10 students with 3 tutors as one group (6 – 8 groups), including 2 days for discussion of clinical cases prepared by the tutors and good clinical journals for epilepsy, analysis of EEGs and video-sessions; another 2 days: prepare one case by students from one group. Gifts to be given to the best case presentation.
